

The **155** road links Akmenė region to the **"Via Baltica**" a highway which connects Western Europe, Scandinavia and Eastern Europe











## FDI in Akmenė region (million EUR)








# Region with the highest FDI per capita in the county



Over 1,200 people employed by FDI manufacturing companies [1] Growth of people employed by FDI companies [1,2]








